Below is a list of supplies from each teacher to help you get started in your new adventure. There may be other supplies required, but you will have plenty of time to buy those during the first days of school. ***Do NOT bring your supplies to 7th Grade Orientation because you will not have a place to put them.***

Bible

Mr. Campbell and Mr. Murphy

- New International Version (NIV) Bible [If you do not have one, you may borrow one from the teacher until you receive your Harding Bible early in the school year.]
- 2 inch three-ring binder
- 5 tab dividers
- white notebook paper (college ruled for Mr. Campbell)
- 2 blue or 2 black ink pens or 2 pencils and a grading pen (color of choice)
- a 3-pack of Playdoh for Mr. Campbell's class

English

Mrs. Hawley and Ms. Murphy

- 1 1/2 inch three-ring binder
- 5 tab dividers
- white notebook paper (wide rule only)
- blue or black ink pen or pencil
- grading pen (any color except blue or black)
- highlighter
- lined 3X5 note cards (You will need 400-500 for the whole year.)
- book cover (large or extra-large only) or you can cover your book with a paper bag
- bag of individually wrapped candy for rewards

Fitness

- extra pair of shorts and T-shirt to keep in your fitness locker (Harding appropriate)
- clean socks
